



## Swedish for Immigrants – SFI

The education in Swedish for Immigrants (SFI) is available for immigrants with another first language than Swedish. At SFI you will learn basic Swedish.

You are allowed to study SFI if you:

- do not have basic knowledge of Swedish
- are registered as an inhabitant in Töreboda kommun
- are at least 16 years of age

At SFI the following courses are available: A, B, C and D. After finishing course D you get a certificate.

In Töreboda you start in the Intro class where your knowledge of Swedish will be tested. You will either continue studying in the Intro class or go to another class depending on your previous knowledge of Swedish.

There is a literacy course if you do not know the Latin alphabet.

The courses involve 15 hours a week, 3 hours every day. There are only morning classes.

You can start SFI whenever you want during the year.

When you apply to SFI you need to bring an identity card. You can order a birth certificate with the mobile Bank-ID.
